An Excerpt from the ISWM Constitution and Bylaws

"Section 2. **Membership.** There shall be five classes of members in the Society as follows: **Active members.**

Honorary Members.

Senior Members

Student Members. Membership shall be granted upon application and approval by the Board of Directors to any student enrolled in courses of study related to weighing and measurement. Student members may not vote or hold Society office or be required to pay dues in the Society. Each new student member will be assigned a sponsor from the active member roles for assistance, as necessary. A limit of 25 active members is placed on this member type throughout 2021 and 2022.

Military Members. Membership shall be granted upon application and approval by the Board of Directors to any active military (or military members released within the last 12 months) in metrological occupations or in courses of study related to weighing and measurement. Military members may not vote or hold Society office or be required to pay dues in the Society. Each new military member will be assigned a sponsor from the active member roles for assistance, as necessary. A limit of 25 active members is placed on this member type throughout 2021 and 2022.

Section 3. **Application for Membership.** Application for membership shall be made according to procedures which may be adopted from time to time by the Board of Directors

Within five working days you will receive communication from the ISWM Executive Director to discuss your application. You will be asked to verify either a course of study that is related to weighing or measurement and/or a current position that you hold that required training of a metrological nature. After this conversation, your application will be reviewed by the ISWM Board of Directors and likely approved for membership. We will then assign you a sponsor who will have 5+ years of experience in the metrological field and whose goal is to assist you with industry related information relevant to your career plans. We will attempt to find a sponsor located near your location.

During this one-year membership these members will have full access to our member database and use of the ISWM Job Board for posting resume's, our technical resource material and our internal training opportunities.

As time progresses, we will reexamine these category membership limits for possible expansion.
